The following questions are included in the 2026 Annual Resident Survey:

Please rate your OVERALL level of agreement with the following statements:

1. Preceptors spend sufficient time TEACHING the residents in my program.
2. Preceptors in my program provide sufficient SUPERVISION of residents (e.g., participate in inpatient rounds, participate in ambulatory patient encounters).
3. Preceptors regularly participate in organized clinical case, disease state, and patient care discussions.
4. I feel comfortable providing honest feedback when I evaluate my PRECEPTORS at the completion of each learning experience.
5. My program provided me access to goals and objectives for each rotation and major assignment.

6. My program provided me the requirements for successful completion of the residency.
7. I receive timely feedback on my performance for each rotation or major assignment.
8. I am provided developmental counseling and evaluation of my progress towards successful achievement of the overall requirements of the residency periodically.
