The updated 2025-2026 ASHP Annual Preceptor Survey and Accreditation Report are included in this release. RPDs will have access to the annual report and preceptors (assigned to a resident’s schedule for the 2024-2025 residency year) will have access to the preceptor survey on August 25 with a deadline of September 12, 2025.

Updated PharmAcademic Terms of Use

The PharmAcademic Terms of Use has been updated. Starting with the release, all users will be required to review and accept the updated terms upon their first login. Once accepted, users won’t be prompted again until the Terms are updated in the future.

PharmAcademic - Terms of Use

PharmAcademic requires that users acknowledge the Terms of Use applicable to PharmAcademic. The Terms of Use provide important information about acceptable and responsible uses of PharmAcademic, convey information about how data collected by PharmAcademic can be used, and define limitations of McCreddie Group's liability. Users are required to accept the Terms of Use as a condition of obtaining access PharmAcademic; after accepting, users will not be prompted again unless there is an update to the Terms of Use.

Welcome to PharmAcademic. In order to continue to use PharmAcademic, you are required to accept and agree to the following Terms of Use.

I understand that PharmAcademic™ is an online tool to support learning for pharmacy residents in programs under the accreditation of ASHP. PharmAcademic is provided by McCreddie Group Software LLC and is licensed by ASHP for use by pharmacy residents.

If you are associated with an ASHP-accredited Residency Program:

I acknowledge that PharmAcademic is used to support pharmacy residency programs and to provide documentation of a systems-based approach to training for ASHP-accredited residencies. ASHP-accredited residency programs are required to use the resident tracking function of PharmAcademic to close out the residents each year.

I further understand that the documentation in the PharmAcademic software may be reviewed by ASHP accreditation surveyors and Commission on Credentialing (COC) members when evaluating a residency program in connection with its accreditation status. I further understand that the information maintained in PharmAcademic is confidential and is intended for use in the training of pharmacy residents and may be accessed and reviewed by the parties specifically stated herein.

If you are associated with a non-accredited Residency Program:

I acknowledge that PharmAcademic is used to support pharmacy residency programs and to provide documentation of a systems-based approach to training for residencies.

I understand that:

- PharmAcademic is provided for use by pharmacy residents, residency program directors, preceptors, and Residency Advisory Committee (RAC) members,
- the information maintained in PharmAcademic is confidential and is intended for use in the training of pharmacy residents, and
- the information maintained in PharmAcademic may be accessed and reviewed by the parties specifically stated herein.

Small Updates and Fixes

- Fixed errors users encountered when requesting support to remove a test resident or report a missing matched resident from their program list.
- Revised text boxes in the electronic Resident Development Plan to ensure appropriate spacing and paragraph breaks appear consistently in both the electronic forms and printed PDF versions.
- Users who attempt to update the APR review status with comments that are too long will now see a validation message on screen indicating that their comment exceeds the maximum length, instead of receiving an error.
- Surveyors are able to update the review status of ASHP Accreditation Reports even after the survey timeframe has ended.
- To enhance security, users updating their email address in PharmAcademic will now be prompted to enter their password."
- Addressed two issues with the new bi-monthly "Outstanding Resident Development Plans" email distributed to RPDs:
 - Ensured the Interim RPD now receives the notification as intended.
 - Corrected the inclusion of E-RDPs that had previously been removed from the recipient list.
